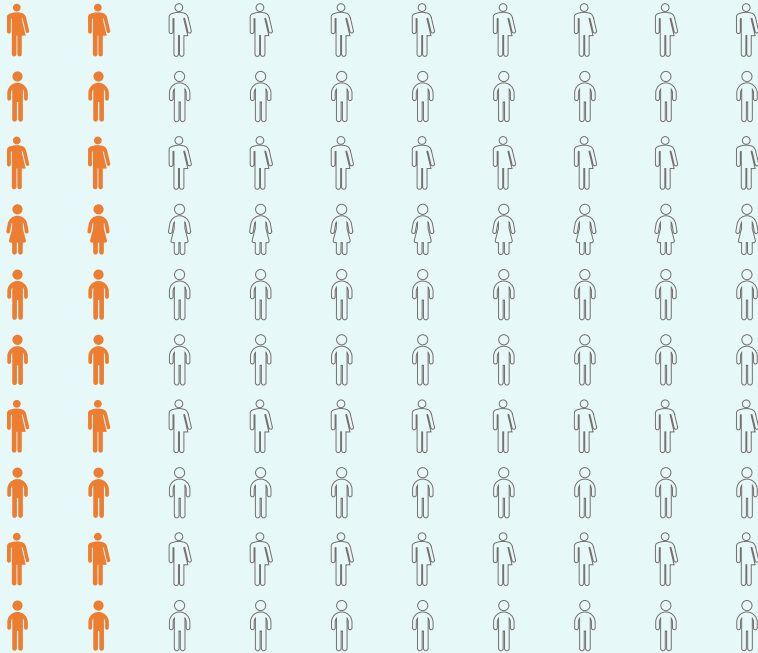
One reason, why we can't get anything done.

 = 1 FTE

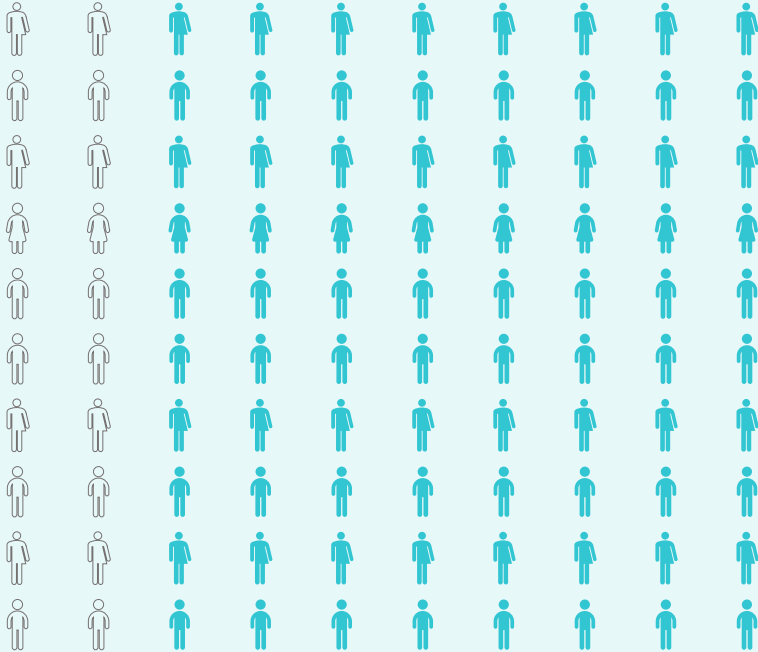
Your company:

(lead, enable, coordinate, control)

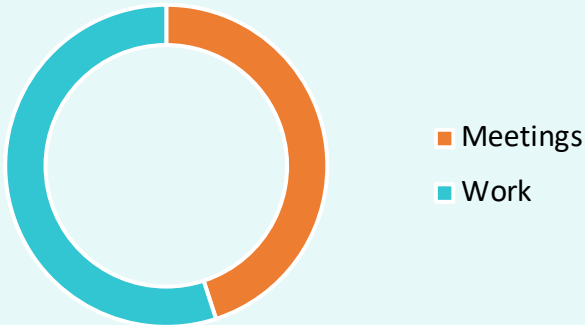


The rest
do the work of the company

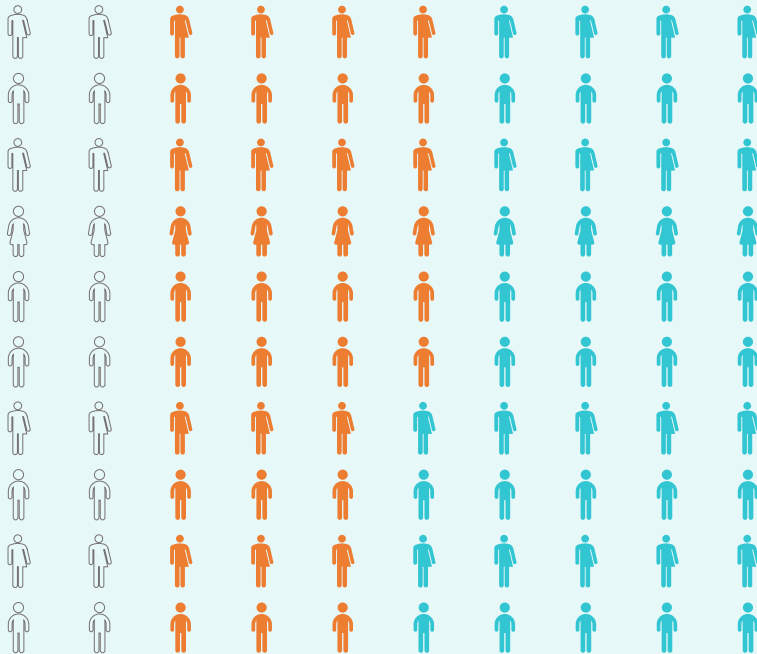


Or, they attend meetings:
18 out of 40 hours (45%)

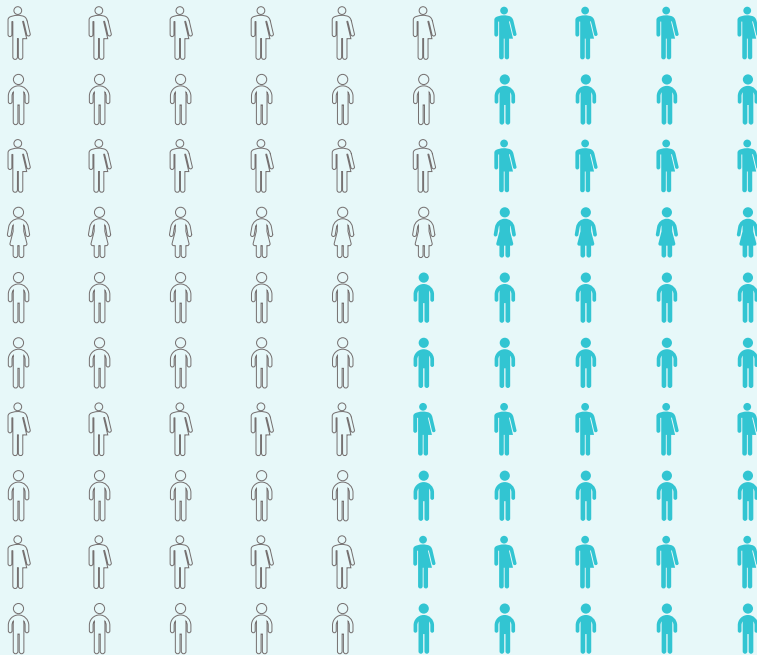
Work Week

80 FTE are in a meeting

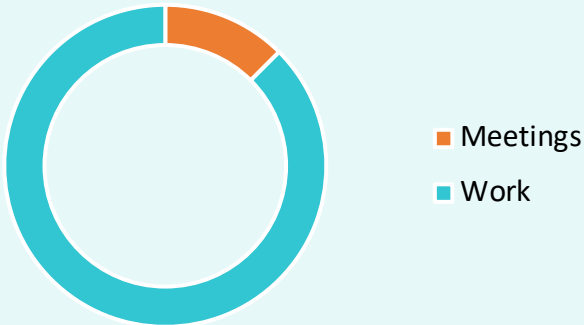


Leaving only 44 FTE to do the

and timeboxed. Max 12%

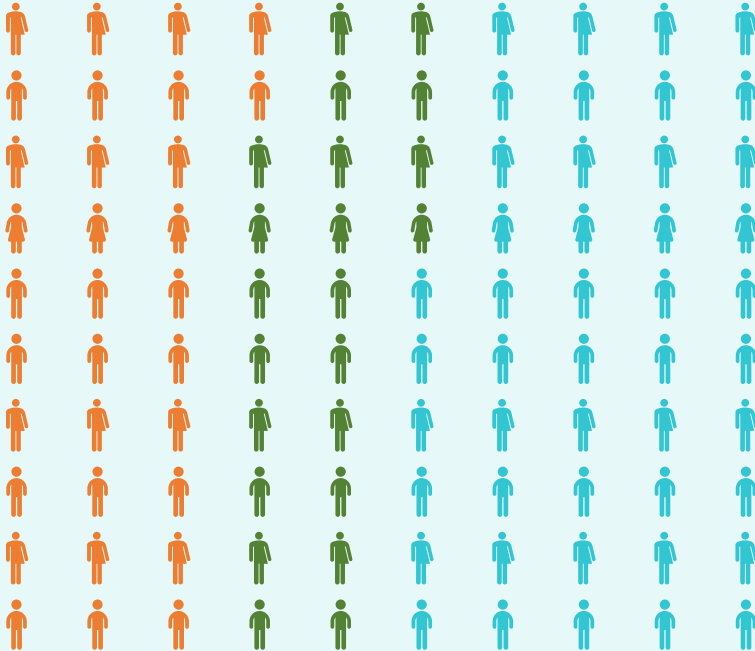
Work Week



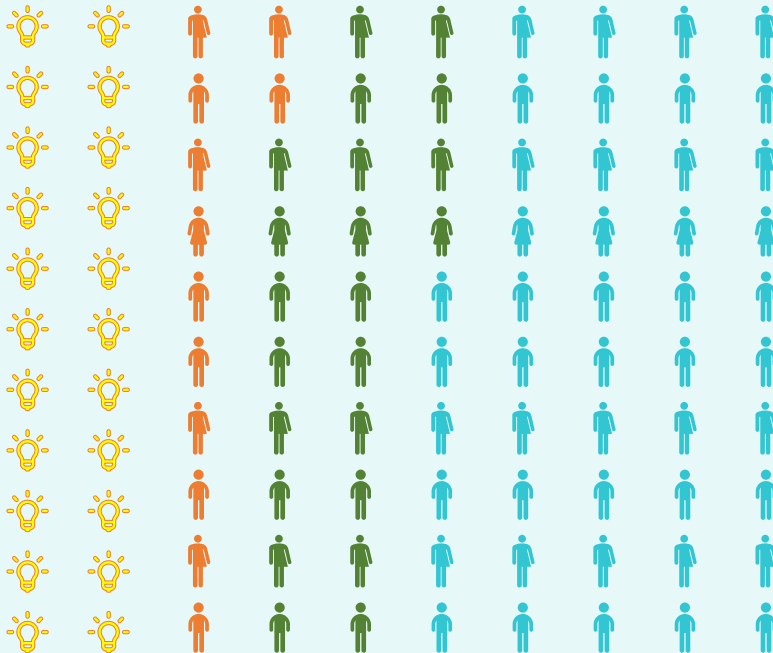
What if, only 12% of your staff
